Each fiscal quarter, the Athens Area Arts Council grants \$500 to organizations, artists, or events that best align with our mission in Athens, GA: "connecting arts to the community" in the most meaningful, substantial, and sustainable ways.



Deadlines are March 15, June 15, September 15, and December 15. Once you apply for this year, your entry will remain in contention throughout the entire year. Therefore, if you apply by March 15 but do not receive the March grant, there is every chance that you could receive the grant in June, September, or December, without having to re-apply.
